

# BUROHELP GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

These General Terms & Conditions govern the use of the **Burohelp Platform**, including the **Burohelp Time Bank**, by nonprofits (ANBIs/PBOs), donors, companies, individuals, volunteers, and all other users.

By creating an account or using the Platform, the User agrees to these Terms.

### 1. Definitions

In these Terms:

- "Foundation" means Stichting Burohelp, the operator of the Platform.
- "Platform" means the Burohelp digital system, including the Time Bank, dashboards, APIs, and all related services.
- "Time Bank" means the hour registration, validation, and impact system used by nonprofits.
- "User" means any natural or legal person using the Platform.
- "Nonprofit" means an ANBI/PBO or comparable organisation registered on the Platform.
- "Donor" means a company, government body, foundation, or individual providing financial or in-kind support.
- "Volunteer" means an individual contributing hours or support.
- "Content" means all data, text, hours, documents, photos, or information entered into the Platform.
- "Agreement" means these Terms between the Foundation and the User.

# 2. Applicability

- 2.1 These Terms apply to all Platform use, access, accounts, registrations, and related services.
- 2.2 Deviations from these Terms are valid only if agreed in writing.
- 2.3 In case of conflict, specific agreements with a User prevail over these Terms.



#### 3. Nature of the Service

#### 3.1 The Foundation provides:

- A platform for nonprofits to register projects, activities, and hours;
- A system enabling donors to support nonprofits;
- Impact insights based on submitted data;
- A secure digital environment for collaboration.

#### 3.2 The Foundation does **not** guarantee:

- Any minimum donation amount;
- Any ongoing support from donors;
- Accuracy of data provided by Users.
- 3.3 The Platform is not intended to replace legal, financial, or professional advice for nonprofits or donors.

#### 4. User Accounts

- 4.1 Users must provide accurate and complete information.
- 4.2 Users are responsible for maintaining confidentiality of login credentials.
- 4.3 The Foundation may suspend or terminate accounts in cases of:
  - misuse
  - fraudulent entries
  - violation of terms
  - legal or safety concerns
  - breach of ANBI/nonprofit eligibility
- 4.4 Users must be at least 18 years old.

#### 5. Use of the Platform

- 5.1 Users shall not:
- a. enter false or misleading hours, activities, or data;
- b. upload harmful, illegal, or defamatory content;
- c. impersonate others;
- d. interfere with system security;
- e. misuse the Platform for non-public-benefit purposes.
- 5.2 Nonprofits must ensure all content they upload is lawful, accurate, and verifiable.



5.3 The Foundation may remove any content that violates these Terms.

## 6. Responsibilities of Nonprofits

#### Nonprofits agree to:

- a. maintain valid ANBI/PBO status or equivalent;
- b. provide accurate and verifiable hour entries;
- c. cooperate with audits or verification requests;
- d. maintain proper internal controls;
- e. ensure volunteers and staff comply with all policies;
- f. use funds received only for public-benefit purposes;
- g. notify the Foundation if eligibility changes.

## 7. Responsibilities of Donors

#### Donors agree to:

- a. respect the Foundation's allocation policies;
- b. provide accurate legal and financial information;
- c. not use donations to influence decision-making improperly;
- d. refrain from imposing discriminatory, political, or illegal conditions.

# 8. Intellectual Property

- 8.1 All rights to the Platform, including software, design, trademarks, and logos, belong to the Foundation or its licensors (including Burohelp BV/CivicBridge BV depending on structure).
- 8.2 Users receive a non-exclusive, non-transferable license to use the Platform for its intended purpose.
- 8.3 Users may not:
  - copy, distribute, or modify the software;
  - reverse engineer the Platform;
  - · create competing services using Foundation IP.

# 9. Data & Privacy

- 9.1 Personal data is processed according to the **Privacy & Data Protection Policy**.
- 9.2 Nonprofits act as independent controllers for data they upload about beneficiaries or



volunteers.

9.3 Users must comply with GDPR/AVG when entering personal data.

# 10. Fees and Payment Conditions

10.1 The Foundation may charge fees for certain services, including:

- premium platform features
- processing of donations
- enterprise accounts for corporate donors
- 10.2 Fees shall be clearly communicated before applying.
- 10.3 Invoices must be paid within 30 days unless agreed otherwise.

## 11. Donations and Financial Distribution

11.1 Donations received through the Foundation are distributed according to transparent policies communicated to donors and nonprofits.

#### 11.2 The Foundation:

- may charge a platform or administrative fee;
- may adjust distributions based on fraud reviews or compliance checks;
- reserves the right to temporarily withhold funds for verification.
- 11.3 Donors cannot impose conditions incompatible with ANBI law.

### 12. Verification and Fraud Prevention

12.1 All Time Bank hours and project data may be:

- audited
- verified
- reviewed
- cross-checked with evidence

12.2 In case of suspected fraud or misuse:

- the Foundation may suspend or delete accounts;
- funds may be frozen;
- authorities may be notified if required.



# 13. Availability & Maintenance

- 13.1 The Foundation strives to maintain high platform availability but does not guarantee uninterrupted access.
- 13.2 Maintenance may occur at any time, with reasonable effort to minimise disruption.
- 13.3 The Foundation is not liable for:
  - data loss
  - downtime
  - delays
  - third-party service interruptions

# 14. Liability

- 14.1 The Foundation's liability is limited to:
  - · direct damages,
  - up to the amount paid by the User to the Foundation during the previous 12 months, unless caused by intent or gross negligence.
- 14.2 The Foundation is **not** liable for:
  - indirect or consequential damages;
  - loss of profits;
  - errors in user-submitted data;
  - activities or omissions of nonprofits or volunteers;
  - external cyberattacks beyond reasonable prevention.

#### 15. Termination

- 15.1 Users may terminate their account at any time.
- 15.2 The Foundation may terminate or suspend access if:
  - the User violates these Terms:
  - compliance or integrity concerns arise;
  - the User no longer meets eligibility requirements;



required by law.

#### 15.3 Upon termination:

- access to the Platform ceases;
- the Foundation may retain necessary data for regulatory compliance.

## 16. Changes to These Terms

- 16.1 The Foundation may update these Terms periodically.
- 16.2 Significant changes will be communicated to Users.
- 16.3 Continued use of the Platform constitutes acceptance of updated Terms.

# 17. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

- 17.1 These Terms are governed by the laws of the **Netherlands**.
- 17.2 Disputes shall be submitted to the **competent court in the Netherlands**, unless the Foundation chooses an alternative dispute resolution method.
